A Residual bequest is either the residue or part residue of your estate after all other legacies, taxes, debts and expenses have been paid.

A Pecuniary bequest is a legacy of a specific sum of money.

If you are making a Will for the first time, we advise you to seek professional assistance, usually from a solicitor.

The cost is usually quite reasonable*. If you've already made a Will, you can add to or change its provisions at any time.
