RAILWAY MISSION (RM) OVERVIEW - We've offered support for over 100 years, but we're totally up to date with the trials of modern living. As a Christian charity at the end of March 2020 we employed 10 full-time, 8 part-time and 2 volunteer chaplains spread across England, Scotland & Wales.

RM Chaplains offer support to railway staff and to passengers affected by railway operations. Our set-up enables us to support those of all faiths and none and to be independent, confidential and impartial.

RM operating costs are some £555k p.a. and our income is some £470k p.a. with 75% of that coming from the railway industry.

GENUINE OCCUPATIONAL REQUIREMENTS - Railway Mission has a genuine occupational requirement for Trustees to have a Christian faith. Before arranging interviews those selected will be asked to confirm by email that, if appointed, they will be able to agree with the Railway Mission Doctrinal, Faith & Lifestyle Statements
